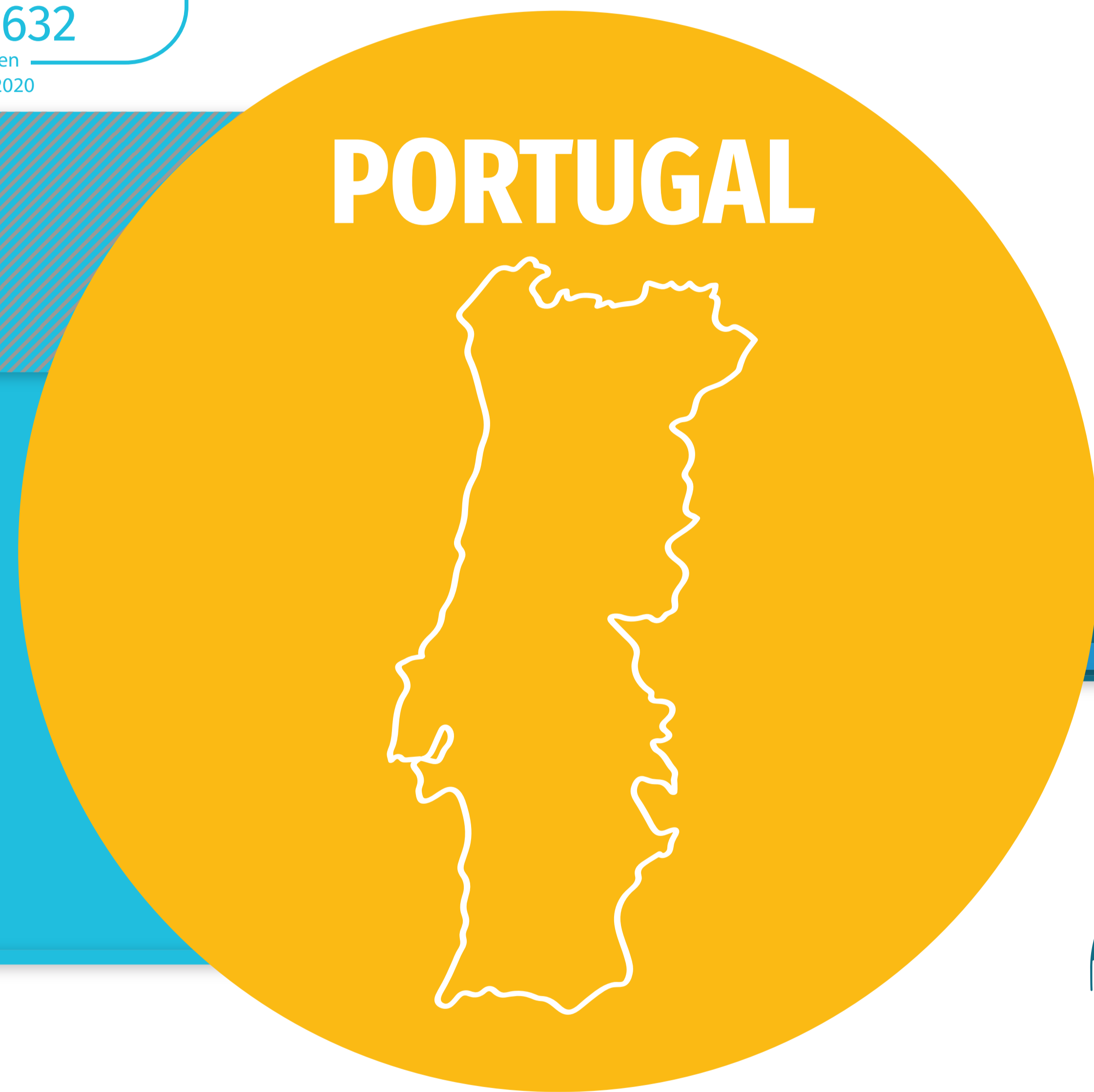

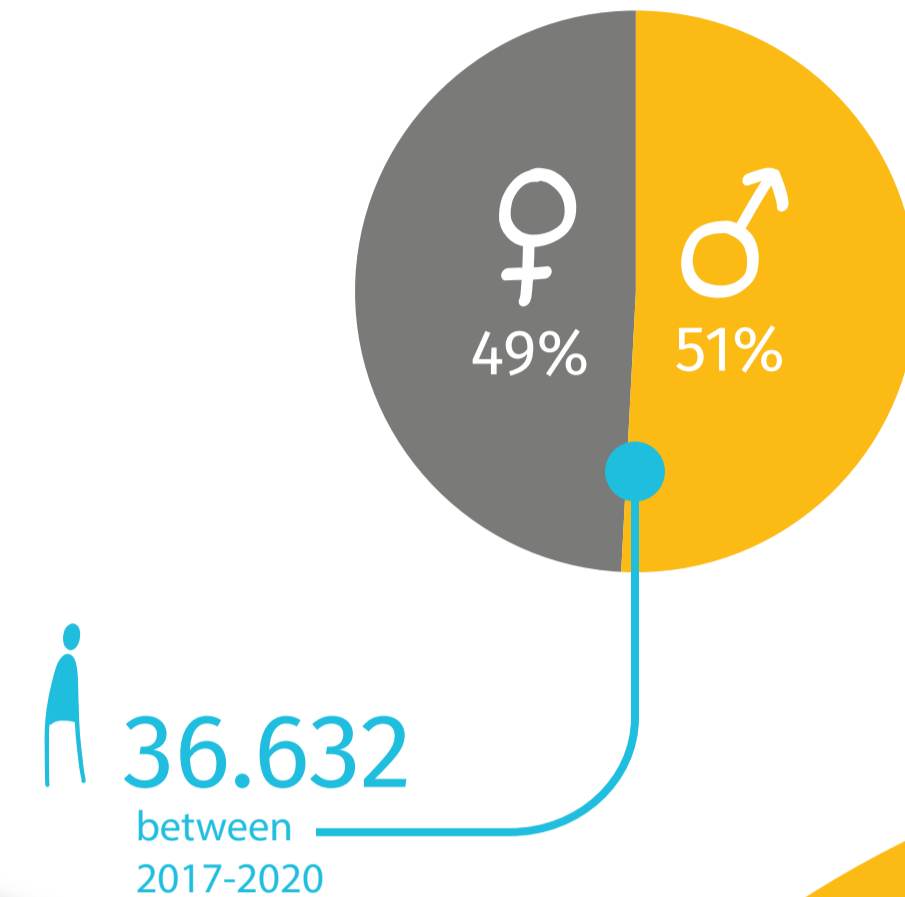
Residence Permit Obtained After Entering as Tourist and Finding a Job

- Main countries of origin: Brazilians, Cape Verdeans, Indians, Bangladeshis, Pakistanis, Nepalis
- Low-skilled work in construction, tourism and agricultural jobs

- Part-time or holiday work in the hotel business, restaurant and tourism sector



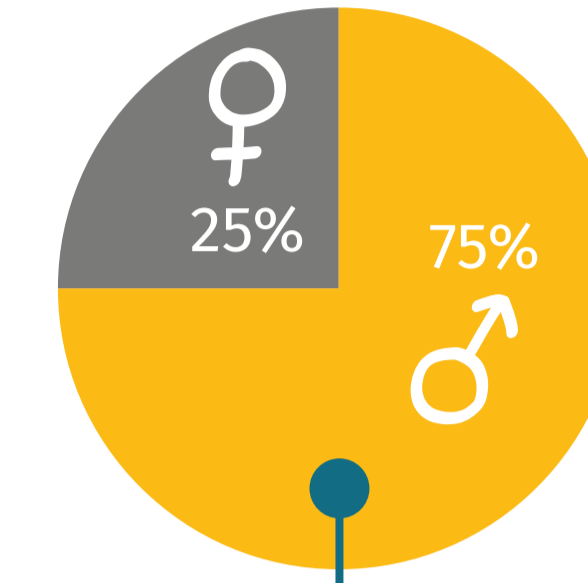
'Golden Visa' for Investors and Businessmen

- Retired people from US, UK, Brazil, Russia, China among others who buy real-estate or make large-scale investments

Residence Visa for Highly Qualified Professionals under an Employment Contract

- Economic elite and highly educated individuals from third countries
- Scientists in the field of physics, biology, mathematics, medicine, for engineers, for CEOs, private company board members and high-level functionaries of public institutions

- Could be any sector but its potential of innovation and the quality and likely success of the business plan are assessed during the visa application process

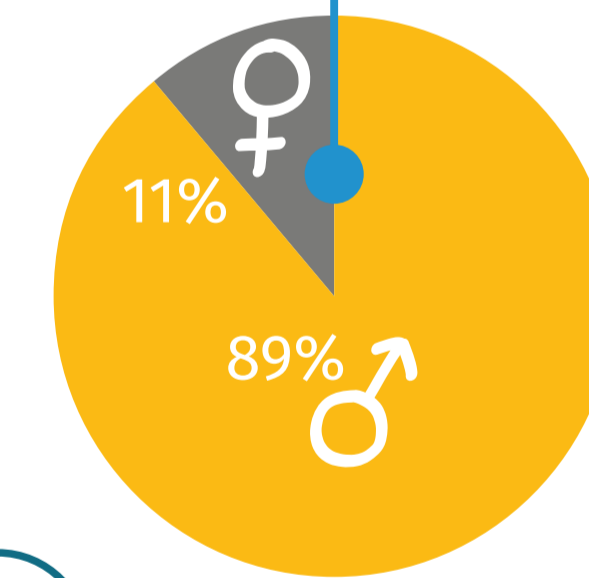
Start-Up Visa for Entrepreneur Immigrants

- Only a few selected individuals from around the world, who are comparatively rich and very highly qualified
- Innovation and technology jobs

Tech Visa

- Mainly from third countries, which are not able to enter Portugal without a tourist visa
- Mid-/High skill: Immigrants who are hired and supported in the visa application process by large and well-established companies
